Question: What is an example from your life where you've made a choice for growth in a challenging situation?

Read Romans 5:5

Question: What does “intentionally leaning into the moment and the practice of being loving” look like in your life today?

Read 1 Corinthians 13:4–7.

Now read it again and replace “Love” or “It” with your name.

Questions: What changes for you with this passage when you put your name in it? How do you respond?
