Questions: What other places in the New Testament does it mention our freedom in Christ? What does it say we are to do with that freedom?

Read Daniel 3

Question: How did these three men demonstrate their fear of God but their submission to the King?

Questions: What is your reaction to 1 Peter 2:18? What does it look like for you to "follow in the steps of Christ" as laid out in verses 22-25?

Good and godly citizenship is when we as people give ourselves over to self-governance.

Question: How does "self-governance" lead to bringing honour to God?

Read Proverbs 29:18

Question: How can this be a prophetic statement over Canada?

Questions: Do you pray for those in authority over you? If so, what do those prayers "look" like?
