Read: Matthew 5:4-6

Questions: How would you define "meekness"? Can you illustrate it by an experience you have had or seen?

It is radical love, not cruel revenge, that brings justice to the world. Revolution without the constraint of power brings further injustice.

Read: Psalm 37:8-11

The way of Jesus:

- Pursue justice for all people, even those you don't agree with.
- Oppose all corruption, not just the corruption that disrupts your self-interests.
- Reject zero tolerance. Embrace radical grace.
- Practice meekness with whatever power you do have.
