Whenever you see the word "friend" in Proverbs, it's equivalent to "neighbour." A good friend / neighbour is:

- **STICKY / CONSTANT**
Read Proverbs 18:24; 17:17

- **CANDOUR / COUNSEL**
Read Proverbs 27:6; 29:5; 27:9,17

- **COURTESY / TACT**
**It not only matters what we say,
but how, when and why we say it**
Read Proverbs 27:14; 25:20; 25:17

- **GOOD CITIZEN**
Read Proverbs 11:11

Questions: What are some other Proverbs that come to mind in these categories? What other categories could be added to this list? Which one of these are you doing well? Which one needs the most improvement?

to cultivate healthy relationships.**

Questions: What are you going to do today to be a good friend / neighbour? How will you prioritize people over tasks? Who needs your time today?
