Question: What do you know about your physical heart?

Read Matthew 22:37–38; Genesis 6-8

Genesis 6:9 (NLT) “Noah was a **righteous** man, the only **blameless** person living on earth at that time, and he **walked in close fellowship** with God.”

Relationship is what God wants most from you.

Questions: How would you describe a relationship with God? How would you describe your relationship?

Read Hosea 6:6 God says “I want you to know Me.”

What does a relationship with God look like?

1. When you love God, you trust God completely.

Read Hebrews 11:7

2. When you love God, you obey God wholeheartedly.

Read Genesis 6:14–16, 22

God doesn’t always explain everything he asks us to do. When you obey, understanding will come.

Questions: When have you obeyed God and not understood? What has God asked you to do that you haven’t yet?

Read John 14:15; 13:34

3. When you love God, you worship him passionately.

Read Genesis 8:20–21; Hebrews 13:15

Anything we do that brings pleasure to God is an act of worship.

Questions: What does worship look like in your life? What is one step you can take to expand your expression of worship?

Read Revelation 1:7; Romans 10:13
