5 GOOD-NEWS TRUTHS ABOUT MARRIAGE:

- 1. The actual divorce rate has never been close to 50%.
- 2. Most marriages are happy.
 - Most couples who are not happy will become happy if they stay committed for five years.
 - A harmful marriage is different from an unhappy marriage.



- 3. The rate of divorce in the church is significantly lower than the non-churchgoing population.
 - Couples who go to church together on a regular basis have the lowest divorce rate of any group studied.
 - If each of you put God at the center of your life and marriage, the closer you get to God and each other.
- 4. Remarriages aren't doomed. A significant majority survive and thrive.
 - Lifetime marriage is God's intent for marriage.
 - **Read** Matthew 19:8
 - If you do the hard work that every couple needs to do you can have a great marriage that lasts a lifetime.
- 5. Most marriage problems aren't big-ticket issues. Fixing little things can often make a big difference.

For too many couples, believing that half of all marriages end in divorce is a reason why some marriages end in divorce.
