**Questions:** What comes to mind when you think of "entitlement"? Has someone ever told you that you're entitled? Have you maybe even thought to yourself "Am I being entitled about \_\_\_\_?"

As you look at the definition of the word "entitlement", there are 2 primary uses:

- The fact of having a right to something
- The belief that you inherently deserve of privileges or special treatment.

# Entitlement is the antithesis of Jesus!

Read Matthew 20:1-16

1. No matter who you are, whatever good you receive is from God!

**Questions:** What have you grown to expect, but shouldn't? What blessings have become expectations?

Read James 1:16-17

2. God isn't fair - He's generous!

Question: If God was fair, what would you deserve?

**Read** Mark 2:17; Romans 3:23; Psalm 14:3; Romans 6:23

### 3. His kingdom is upside down.

**Question:** Why do you think the Kingdom of Heaven is considered upside down?

#### The Kingdom of Heaven isn't actually upside down, it's right side up and Jesus is inviting us to get it straight!

Read Mark 15 & Philippians 2:5-11

**Question:** How does Jesus show the antithesis of entitlement in who He was and how He was going to win the battle against satan, sin and death?
