Question: What is your experience or observation of the “flow” of water in the ocean?

**Water is made to flow.
The flow brings life.**

Read John 7:37–39

On the Day of Pentecost, Jesus poured out the promised Holy Spirit upon the church.

To be a Christian is to believe that:

“There is one God, the creator, who exists eternally in unity as three equal persons: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.”¹

Different ways that we can approach the Holy Spirit:

1. Forget about the Holy Spirit

Read Acts 19:2

Arianism, a heresy in the ancient church said: Only the Father is God. The Son Jesus is a lower being than God and the Holy Spirit is just a force or presence.

2. Frightened of the Holy Spirit

Question: What have you seen or heard about the Holy Spirit that could cause discomfort or rejection?

3. Force the Holy Spirit

Sabellianism, another ancient heresy said: God is revealed in three different stages culminating with the Spirit as the ultimate revelation of God.

Read 1 Corinthians 14:1, 39

Question: What have you seen or heard about the Holy Spirit that was forced or manipulated?

4. Flow in the Holy Spirit

Read John 7:37–39

The Festival of Shelters celebrated the provision of the harvest and commemorated 40 years of God’s supernatural provision in the wilderness.

Read Zechariah 14:8; Isaiah 12:3

When the Holy Spirit was poured out, He brought LIFE!

Questions: Which one of the first 3 approaches to the Holy Spirit do you need to leave behind in order to embrace the Flow? Will you pray that ancient prayer, “Come, Holy Spirit” now?
