Read John 7:38-39

Questions: Are you or have you been a “waterslider”?
What is the best waterslide that you have been on?

There is **one God**, the creator, who exists eternally in unity as **three equal persons**: Father, Son, and **Holy Spirit**.

If you don’t see the Holy Spirit as a person, you won’t seek a personal relationship with him.

- Jesus doesn’t just save you from something – sin.
- Jesus saves you for something - a relationship with the Holy Spirit.

Read John 1:29–34

1. Jesus came to take away the sin of the world.

People can be good. How would you answer the **question**: “How good is good enough?”

Read John 1:29; I John 1:9

2. Jesus is the one who will baptize you with the Holy Spirit.

Read John 1:33; Acts 2:4; Acts 1:4-5; Acts 2:17–18

Christianity was always supposed to be a movement in which tongues, prophecy, visions, healings, energetic worship, and experience with Holy Spirit were normative spiritual experience.

Read Acts 2:38-39

Three things that happened to every follower of Jesus in the early church: **Salvation, Water baptism, Spirit baptism**

1. Philip in Samaria
Read Acts 8:12, 15–17
2. Saul (Paul) in Damascus
Read Acts 9:17
3. Peter with Cornelius
Read Acts 10:44-48
4. Paul in Ephesus
Read Acts 19:1–2, 5–6

Scripture is clear:

- Jesus is our Savior; we need to experience salvation.
- When we believe in Jesus, we are to get baptized in water.
- When we believe in Jesus, He wants to baptize us in Holy Spirit.

Question: Will you pray the ancient prayer "Come, Holy Spirit."?
