Read 1 Corinthians 15:58 – 16:4

**How we live now effects the life to come.
The life to come effects how we live now.**

Question: How does reading 1 Corinthians 15:58 with money and giving in mind effect how you see this verse?

Significant principles about giving for followers of Jesus:

- Giving is an act of worship.

Read Philippians 4:18

Question: How does giving as an act of worship change how you view giving?

- Giving should be systematic.

Questions: How does systematic giving look like to you? How does it compare and how does it differ from

principles of financial investments? What has been your experience with “special” offerings?

- Giving is personal and individual.
- Giving is to be proportionate.

Questions: How has God prospered you? How does the recognition of this effect your giving? In the light of resurrection, how do you answer the preceding questions?

Questions: How are you growing your heart of generosity? What are you doing and what will you do to encourage this growth?
