**Question:** What is your best memory of Pastor Darcy and or Aileen over the last 18 years?

**Read** Genesis 26:12–15

Throughout scripture, water is a symbol of spiritual life.

**Read** Psalm 42:1; 63:1; Isaiah 12:3; John 4:7-10, 13-14

**Digging a well is symbol of pursuing  
your relationship with Jesus.**

**What we can learn from Isaac, the well digger:**

- **Just because you found water doesn't mean everyone is going to like it.**

**Question:** When has someone “kicked dirt into your well”?

**It's not enough to be right.**

If people don't like your well, don't get mad, just keep digging.

**Read** Genesis 26:17–18

- **Each generation needs to re-dig the well.**
- **When you dig a well, you're serving the next generation.**

**Read** Genesis 26:19

- **Teach others to dig wells.**

**If you want to make a difference in somebody's life teach them how to dig a well and find the water of life.**

**Questions:** Who taught you how to “dig a well”? Who are you teaching or who will you teach?

**Read** Psalm 78:4–7

**Read** Genesis 26:20

- **It's easy to argue about who owns the well.**

**We need to put down our preferences  
and pick up our shovels!**

**Read** Genesis 26:32

- **Wells don't happen by themselves; they need to be dug.**

**But those who drink the water I give them will never be thirsty again. It becomes a fresh, bubbling spring within them, giving them eternal life.**

Jesus (John 4: 14)
